

International Study Program

The International Study Program is the DHBW Ravensburg offer of English-taught classes.

Organized parallel to the regular academic calendar of the DHBW Ravensburg, it consists of four quarters (three-month terms). A full semester workload, with at least 30 ECTS credits, is offered in each of the four terms, with similar course outline in the fall and winter term resp. spring and summer term.

Because of this full workload in each term it is possible to stay only for a single term, as well as to combine either the previous quarter or the following quarter in order to complete a full semester workload within six months, or to cover the workload of a full academic year within nine or twelve months.

For some major subjects (see course list) the student can also elect to do practice-oriented research/project work, under the guidance of a DHBW-lecturer. This enables us to offer a very flexible study program.

Students can arrive in either October, January, April or July and they can stay for three, six, nine or even twelve months. The classes are taught either together with our German students or, in separate classes with only international exchange students.
