

Travel Insurance Packages and Prices 2013/2014

CEPA Europe has teamed up with CareMed International Insurance to offer comprehensive travel and medical insurance packages at affordable rates to our study abroad students and faculty traveling to Europe on one of our programs.

While we are expecting that your upcoming study abroad program or internship in Europe will be a great experience, you should make sure that your insurance covers medical expenses or emergency medical evacuation arising from unexpected accidents or minor illnesses. Your domestic health insurance will probably not provide you with such protection for this and other risks. You could face extensive unexpected costs while abroad, especially if you do not have a comprehensive travel health plan. The following two insurance packages are available. Comprehensive Gold Package	
Travel Health/Accident Insurance (HA)	Covers essential medical treatment for illness or injury suffered while travelling outside your home country during your period of coverage. This includes treatment by a doctor, treatment in hospital and medication.
Travel Accident Indemnity Insurance (I)	The Travel Accident Indemnity benefit plan will pay a one-time sum (invalidity benefit) if you suffer permanent disability as a result of an accident (e.g. restricted mobility, paralysis or amputation). The level of invalidity benefit depends on the agreed insurance sum and on the degree of impairment.
Travel Assistance Insurance (T)	Covers expenses for transport and accommodation for close family members, in the case you are hospitalized due to a life threatening condition or you will be hospitalized as an inpatient for a certain period of time.
Travel Luggage Insurance (L)	Covers checked luggage which is lost or damaged or if the luggage is lost or damaged as a result of theft, fire or elemental occurrences.
Travel Third Party Liability Insurance (3)	Covers you during your journey against the dangers of everyday life for which you are responsible and must therefore remunerate others. In such cases the insurer not only regulates the damages, but also checks whether, and to what extent, a compensation liability exists. Unjustified claims for compensation are reviewed and managed by the insurer on your behalf and, to this extent, the plan also provides legal protection in case of unjustified liability claims.
